



## AIRDRIE AND DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIPS

- A. Agriculture Scholarship  
or  
B. Non-Agricultural Studies Scholarship

Can be used at:	Any accredited post-secondary institution
Eligible candidates:	Must have graduated from any Airdrie, Alberta high school within twelve months of the date of application.
Year of study:	First
Program of study:	Any diploma, certificate or degree program
Value of scholarship:	\$1000.00 (one thousand dollars)
Number of scholarships:	Two (1 – Agriculture & 1 – Non-Agricultural Studies)
Criteria:	Selection of the successful candidate will be done on the following basis, with each of the three areas receiving equal weighting. <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Academic Achievement: only and all grade twelve marks will be used.</li><li>2. Extracurricular Activities: includes but is not limited to school related activities and sports.</li><li>3. Essay: a) length 250-300 words b) title – “The Value of Volunteerism”</li></ol>
Note:	The scholarship will not be paid unless the candidate has successfully completed one term of study and remains enrolled full-time in an appropriate course of study at an approved post-secondary institution. Proof of enrollment in 2nd Semester is required.
Selection committee:	The selection committee shall be comprised of three individuals who are at arms length from any applicant for the scholarship. This committee must be established at any regular meeting of the Airdrie and District Agricultural Society. The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.
